Restrictions on Hazardous Substances (RoHS) 2

Regarding Northern Technologies position with respect to:

The new RoHS2 Directive 2011/65/EU becomes effective on January 3, 2013 and deals with the same hazardous substances and maximum concentration limits as the previous (RoHS) 1 (Directive 2002/95/EC).

All of the products currently meeting the substance restrictions of (RoHS) 1 are in compliance with the substance restrictions of (RoHS) 2.

The WEEE Recast 2012/19/EU or (WEEE2) as it may well be referred to was published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 24 July 2012 defines the recovery of waste electrical and electronic equipment.
